SUBJECT : Review of Records about Drug Experimentation

REFERENCE: Your memorandum dated 3 October 1978, Subject as above

1. Your nagging uncertainty is contagious. Hence, since receipt of reference memorandum, I have spent a considerable amount of time with Chief, Executive Registry, reviewing what it is we may have on file related to the MKULTRA program. As you know, DCI Registry files are almost exclusively composed of copies of material forwarded to the DCI and DDCI. I have satisfied myself that we are in possession of no undisclosed material containing the names of tested individuals which has surfaced since the investigations commenced. Furthermore, a review of what might be squirreled away in Records Center has revealed the attached memorandum dated 15 April 1960, wherein the Chief/Executive Registry/DCI instructed that materials related to MKULTRA and ARTICHOKE be destroyed. An examination of the Job number suggests that the materials had to do with authorizing expenditure of funds for specific operations 1951-55. I doubt that any of these materials mentioned the names of those being tested.

2. There are four boxes of material retired by the Executive Registry and presently having to do with MKULTRA. This material is dated 1972-75. I am fairly confident that these boxes will contain nothing responsive to your request, but I have recalled same and will review and advise.
